Requirements for the Major in History: Undergraduate majors are required to take at least 27 credits at the 2000-level or above, which must include one 3-credit course from each of Groups A, B, and C, and two 3-credit courses from Group D. The remaining six credits may be from a Group / Groups of your choice. All majors must take HIST 2100 in the semester following their declaration as majors, and all majors except Honors students must take HIST 4994W in their senior year. **Honors students** should take in sequence 4999 / 4994W and 4997W. **Under certain circumstances and with advisor approval, honors majors may substitute 4994W for 4999.** With the consent of the undergraduate major's advisor, graduate level courses may be used to fulfill the distribution requirement. HIST 2100 and 4994W satisfy the information literacy competency. HIST 4994W or 4997W satisfy the writing in the major requirements.
